

## unpack

<p><code>&lt;number(s)&gt;</code> types the three character name for the specified packed integer value(s)</p>
--

Use **unpack** to type a three-character name for a specified packed integer value. It performs the opposite operation to **pack**.

### Examples

```
unpack 26219, 26232, 30786, 30792
```

This command unpacks the specified integer values. Semper produces the following output:

```
26219 unpacks to 'pos'  
26232 unpacks to 'po2'  
30786 unpacks to 'siz'  
30792 unpacks to 'si2'
```
